This seminar explores the use of Welfare Guardianship for a person with an intellectual disability once they turn 18yrs. Also discussed is the use of a Trust for managing assets. Sample legal documents are provided on a CD and questions are encouraged. Each family attending receives a comprehensive resource pack of information.
