Drumming (Advertisement)Hi my name is Chewy and I would like to introduce myself and the sessions I run.

After working with Rhythm Interactive for over 2 years, performing interactive drumming shows in schools all over New Zealand (www.rhythminteractive.co.nz), I decided to moved into music therapy.

I offer fun interactive music sessions that suits children at all levels (disabled and none disabled) that involves the use of drums, shakers, other percussion, singing, dancing, games, loop pedal, digeridoo, and other instruments from around the world. These sessions are available for groups or individuals and will always be tailored to meet the ability levels of the participants.

There are sessions currently running at The Wilson Centre and the responses from students has been awesome.

I also run drum therapy sessions called DRUMBEAT (Discovering Relationships Using

Music, Beliefs, Emotions, Attitudes & Thoughts).

DRUMBEAT is a therapeutic 10 session (usually 1 session @ 1 - 1.5 hours per week) flexible interactive program that combines learning music with cognitive behavioural therapy and engages young people (and adults) who may have difficulties in the classroom for different reasons. DRUMBEAT uses rhythm to help reach young people who are at risk of problematic health and social outcomes. It teaches values that the students can transfer from the sessions into their every day lives. The programme suits students ages 8 and up who are able to learn rhythms and have open discussions.

I have worked in the disability and support industry for around 8 years in multiple areas and have a very good understanding disabled people and their needs. Helping people have fun and a creative independent life is what I am passionate about. Session fees are worked out depending on need and numbers of participants.
