This initiative is being developed by the Parent & Family Resource Centre, Manukau SuperClinic (CMDHB), Parent to Parent Auckland, The Asian Network Inc., Autism New Zealand Auckland branch, Independent Living Service and IDEA ASD Comms/ASD-Plus Specialist Service – with support from the CALD project (Culturally and Linguistically Diverse).

All Chinese families of a child with autism are warmly invited to this meeting on 20 August. This meeting will be held at the Papatoetoe Taikura Trust office (that is the primary Needs Assessment and Service Coordination organisation (NASC) in Auckland). The meeting will focus on eligibility for Ministry of Health funded supports, the types of supports that may be available for people who are on the Autism Spectrum, as well as what may be involved in the process of being reassessed for existing supports.

There will also be an opportunity for families to ask any questions they may have around getting support from Taikura Trust. Sanny Chan from the Independent Living Service (ILS) will facilitate and provide on the spot translation on the day. **The workshop will start promptly at 10am.**
